Rulebook 24/25

1. Applications

To access the Discord channels for the championship, you need to have the "SIMGEAR Rally Cup" role. Only participants in the championship are given this role, after submitting an application.

The championship remains open to new drivers throughout the season, allowing them to join at any time, along with their team or as part of another team.

It is recommended to discuss your participation intentions with the organizers before each race to ensure smooth media coverage, confirm your Discord role, and avoid missing important information.

2. Cars

All cars in the R5 and R4 categories are available for selection.

Each driver must declare their car in advance and is not allowed to change it during the season. If no car has been declared in advance, the driver is required to compete with the car they used in their first rally of the championship.

3. Classes and Standings

3.1 Classes

Drivers will be divided into two classes according to their cars.

Class R5 includes the R5 group

Class R4 includes the R4 group

3.2 Standings

General standings

Standings by class (R5 and R4)

Team standings

The weakest performance of each driver throughout the season will be removed when calculating the final standings.

4. Teams

Teams can be formed with a minimum of two and a maximum of five drivers. Within each team, drivers are free to choose their cars.

Points for the team standings are awarded based on the results of the two highest-ranked drivers in the general standings of each rally.

Drivers who have not specified a team will be administratively grouped with other participants without a team in the championship.

The organizers reserve the right to adjust the name of a team or their skin.

5. Championship

The championship will consist of five rounds on the RBR platform, using the Hungarian plugin: <https://rallysimfans.hu/rbr/download.php?download=rsfrbr>

The rallies will be divided into two or three virtual racing days. Each driver has the opportunity to compete from Friday at 20:00 until Sunday at 23:49 (Bulgarian time GMT +2).

Each event will have an option for retired drivers to continue under the "Super Rally" system in the next Leg of the event.

The rally configuration will be announced on Friday before the start of the rally – in the #road-book section in Discord.

7.1 Bonus Points

Power Stage

The final stage of each rally will award bonus points to the top 10 in the general standings for that specific stage.

These points will be added to the drivers' totals in the general standings.

7.2 Points for Team Standings

The team standings points are based on the two best-performing drivers in the team, depending on the points they earn in the general standings for the given rally.

7.3 Points for Classes

Each driver earns points for their class according to their position in the general standings of the given rally.

8. Skins

Each driver or team must send their skins in a private message on Discord to Iskren Pondev. Otherwise, default skins will be assigned.

It is recommended that team skins be identical.

Each driver must keep their skin for the entire season.

The organizers reserve the right to approve or disapprove the overall or partial design of the skins.

The organizers reserve the right to add special advertising logos to the skins of the championship participants.

The use of skins that, in any way, violate basic human rights, good manners, or the image of the championship is not tolerated.

All political slogans, statements, and references are strictly prohibited!

9. Replay

All drivers are required to keep their replays after the rally.

The organizer reserves the right to request replays from the competitors at any time, and they are obligated to provide them.

10. Prizes

- **If you have registered but have not received €15 in your account, please contact the championship organizer Iskren Pondev on Discord.**
- **For the second consecutive year, our rally championship is supported by SG-Racing, who will once again contribute to the prize pool with a sequential shifter for the winner of the overall standings.**
